

FAILURE TO SUBMIT A DISINFECTANT LEVEL QUARTERLY OPERATING REPORT (DLQOR)

MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The CITYOF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY water system PWS ID 2050071 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAX), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfections residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of July, August and September 2016.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: More diligent reporting procedures will be followed in the future to insure the reports are filed in a timely way.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
