IX. New Business: Discussion and Possible Action

Item A: Approve/Disapprove funds to refurbish lift stations.

Mayor Gillespie stated the Lift Stations need some refurbishing; it will cost approximately \$12,300 to replace the corroding steel pipes with PVC pipe. The funds are available in the budget for maintenance and in the Reserve fund. He would like to start refurbishing Lift Station #1. Alderman Ehmann made the motion to approve funds up to \$12,300 to refurbish Lift Station #1. Alderman Merrick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Item B: Discuss street repairs.

Discussion was held covering which streets will be worked on; Live Oak between Starlight and Woodhaven, Huisache, Driftwood and Tanglewood. The streets have been surveyed to help straighten and widen the streets. Some of the streets meander and need to be straightened; the City

will work with any property owners who may be affected by the process. The streets will be done in the same manner as the other streets in the City.
