**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
March 7, 2017

- I. City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ehmann at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Mayor Ehmann gave the invocation.
- III. Mayor Ehmann led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- IV. Roll Call: Present were: Mayor Ehmann, Alderman Tucker, Merrick, Hewitt, Gillespie and Robbins.

- VII. **Citizen Participation**

- IX. **New Business: Discussion and Possible Action**  
  
Item A: Approve/Disapprove Ordinance Declaring each unopposed Candidate in the May 6, 2017 Election elected to office without requirement of vote  
Alderman Merrick made the motion to approve the Ordinance Declaring each unopposed Candidate in the May 6, 2017 Election elected to office without requirement of vote. Alderman Hewitt seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.  
  
Item B: Approve/Disapprove Interlocal Agreement with San Patricio County for road repairs  
County Commissioner Howard Gillespie went over the agreement. Alderman Gillespie made the motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement with San Patricio County for road repairs. Alderman Robbins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

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Item C: Discuss proposed road work and over hanging trees

Discussion occurred concerning the length of the project, approximately 4,242 feet of Sunset Drive. To include the approaches to the side streets as needed with a 19 foot wide street. Drainage will not be affected on the highway, and most of the drainage along Sunset has been completed. The cost will be approximately \$63,500 to \$71,500.

Trees along Sunset will be looked at and citizens will be notified of any that need to be trimmed on their property. All water lines have been repaired and no new sewer lines will need to be placed. This item will be placed back on the agenda when a firm cost is established.


X. Mayor Ehmann adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
