

Ordinance No. 1993-001

**AN ORDINANCE
ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL;
CREATING THE OFFICE OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER;
TRANSFERRING DUTIES TO SUCH OFFICER; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY:


SECTION 1. The Office of Marshal is provided for by the Local Government Code. The Office of Marshal for Ingleside on the Bay has been vacant for some time and no candidate ran for the office in the last election. The City Council of Ingleside on the Bay, having reviewed State law, its ordinances and the general public health, safety and welfare finds and determines that such office is not necessary for the citizens of Ingleside on the Bay. Therefore, the Office Marshal is hereby abolished.

SECTION 2. There is hereby created the Office of Code Enforcement Officer. The Code Enforcement Officer's duties are to enforce all ordinances, rules and regulations of Ingleside on the Bay. The Code Enforcement Officer will be appointed by the City Council and serve at the pleasure of the City Council. The Code Enforcement Officer may be removed at any time by the City Council for any reason whatsoever. The City Council need not specify any reason for removing the Code Enforcement Officer. The Code Enforcement Officer will not be an employee of Ingleside on the Bay. The duties of the Code Enforcement Officer are strictly limited to enforcement of the ordinances, rules and regulations of Ingleside on the Bay.

SECTION 3. The duties of the Office of Marshal as they relate to enforcement of Ingleside on the Bay ordinances, rules and regulations only are hereby transferred to the Code Enforcement Officer. Any duties of the Marshal with regard to enforcement of State, Federal or any jurisdiction except Ingleside on the Bay are hereby abolished.

SECTION 4. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance by publishing the caption hereof one time in the official newspaper and by posting the caption in three public places within Ingleside on the Bay.

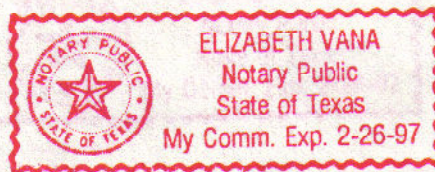
