AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE  
ADOPTION OF A MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX AT  
THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION DATE FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the City of Ingleside on the Bay is desirous of submitting to the Voters the question of whether to adopt a municipal sales and use tax;

WHEREAS, the next available uniform election date is the election in January, 1994 for municipal officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The municipal elections for Mayor and two alderman are hereby called for January 15, 1994.

SECTION 2. There shall also be placed on the ballot a proposition to adopt the municipal sales and use tax provided in Subtitle c., Chapter 321, Texas Tax Code. The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition:

"A one (1) percent sales and use tax is adopted within the City."

SECTION 3. PAT GIRARD-NEUMAN is appointed Election Judge for said election. Provision shall be made for absentee ballots to be cast and the election shall be held in accordance with the Texas Election Code.
