

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-03

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TAX RATE AND LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY FOR THE 2005-2006 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY:

SECTION I. That a tax rate of point one six four one five one on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation is hereby adopted for the tax year 2005.

SECTION II. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Ingleside on the Bay for the 1998-1999 fiscal year, upon all property, real, within the corporate limits of said City, subject to taxation, a tax of point one six four one five one on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purpose here set forth:

1. For maintenance and support of the general government (General Fund) \$.164151 on each \$100.00 valuation of property.

SECTION III. That taxed levied under this Ordinance shall be due October 1, 2005 and if not paid on or before January 31, 2006 shall immediately become delinquent.

SECTION IV. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assesses, and the City Assessor and Collector of the City of Ingleside on the Bay is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and Ordinances for the City of Ingleside on the Bay shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, or the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest and the interest and penalty collected from such delinquent taxes shall be apportioned to the general fund of the City of Ingleside on the Bay. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest from the date of delinquency at the rate prescribed by state law.

SECTION V. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

PASSED this the 20th day of SEPT, 2005, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay, there being a quorum present, by 6 Yeas and 0 Nays, and approved by the Mayor on the date set out.
