

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-04

**AN ORDINANCE
REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR FILMING WITHIN
THE CITY UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; PROVIDING A FEE;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERANCE; PROVIDING A PENALTY;
AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, Ingleside on the Bay is an attractive community with many attractive views; and

WHEREAS, Ingleside on the Bay is a residential community which is tranquil in nature; and

WHEREAS, Ingleside on the Bay is attractive to film companies and individuals to use as a backdrop; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens to require a permit for filming companies and individuals to use the City as a background under certain circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY:

Section 1. The Whereas clauses above are adopted herein by this reference.

Section 2. A permit shall be required of any film company or non-resident of Ingleside on the Bay who films within the City using public property and using the City as a backdrop. A permit shall not be required of a resident of Ingleside on the Bay who is filming their own property or filming their family and/or guests.

Section 3. Any film company or non-resident desiring to film using public property and using the City as a backdrop except established public media, shall apply for a permit from the City Secretary. The application shall be on forms provided by the City and be in the form attached hereto. The applicant shall pay a fee of \$250.00 for the permit plus \$25.00 per person who will be in the City filming. Permits will be approved by City Council and will expire five days from the date of issue.

Section 4. If any provision, section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of this Ordinance to any person or set of circumstances is, for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof or provisions or regulations or regulations contained herein, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any constitutionality of any other portion hereof and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable for that purpose.

Section 5. Any violation of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00. Each day shall constitute a separate offense.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon the publication of the caption hereof in the official newspaper of the City of Ingleside on the Bay; the City Secretary is authorized and directed to provide for such publication.

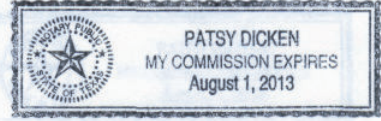
