

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS ADOPTING THE 2012 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, ERECTION, INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, REPAIR, LOCATION, RELOCATION, REPLACEMENT, ADDITION TO, USE OR MAINTENANCE OF MECHANICAL SYSTEMS IN THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; REPEALING ORDINANCE 2006-01 OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, one copy of which is on file in the office of the City Secretary of the City of Ingleside on the Bay, Texas, being marked and designated as the International Mechanical Code, 2012 edition, including all Appendix Chapters, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Mechanical Code of the City of Ingleside on the Bay, in the State of Texas for regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of mechanical systems as herein provided; ; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Mechanical Code on file in the office of the City Secretary are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this legislation, with the additions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. The following sections are hereby revised:

Section 101.1: The City of Ingleside on the Bay, Texas

Section 106.5.2: Exhibit A

Section 106.5.3: 100%

Section 108.4: misdemeanor; five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per day per offense; 10 days

Section 108.5: five hundred dollars (\$500.00)

Section 3. That Ordinance 2006-01 An Ordinance Adopting the International Residential Code, and all other ordinances or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this legislation is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have

passed this law, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrase be declared unconstitutional.

Section 5. That nothing in this legislation or in the Mechanical Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this law; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this legislation.


Section 6. That the City Secretary is hereby ordered and directed to cause this legislation to be published.

Section 7. That this law and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirement, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after the date of its passage and adoption.



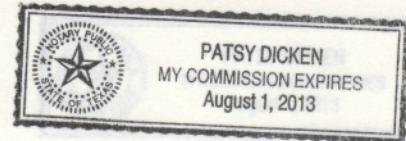
